The School offers students the English National Curriculum up to (I)GCSE and the IB Diploma in the Sixth Form, with a wide range of co-curricular activities throughout. Teaching staff work in a positive and friendly atmosphere with bright and responsive students. The last three cohorts have gained an average of over 35 IB diploma points, and (I)GCSE results in the same period have yielded an A*/A grade (or equivalent) average of 60%, with 97% achieving A* – C grades.

The most recent ISI Inspection (November 2017) affirmed that pupils make 'excellent progress', while the quality of pupils' learning and achievement and the quality of pupils' personal development were both rated 'excellent' overall.
